Vintage Hydraulic [pre 1959]

CLASS 4 GREY FERGUSON

Following Society of Ploughmen Rules, found on Avebury & District Website

CLASS 5 OPEN CONVENTIONAL [3,4,5 & 6 FURROW]

(non-vintage)

For mounted and trailed ploughs drawn by a wheeled tractor

CLASS 6 NOVICE CLASS

Following Society of Ploughmen Rules for Novice competitors, found on Avebury & District Website

CLASS 7 – REVERSIBLE MOUNTED

For 4 or more furrow reversible mounted ploughs drawn by a wheeled tractor [supplementary rule applies]

CLASS 8 – REVERSIBLE SEMI MOUNTED

For 5 or more furrow reversible semi-mounted ploughs drawn by a wheeled tractor [supplementary rule applies]

CLASS 9 – TRADE

9A Trade Conventional & 9B Trade Reversible

Ploughing by mounted or semi-mounted ploughs of 4 or more furrows drawn by a wheeled tractor
